For surgeons by surgeons

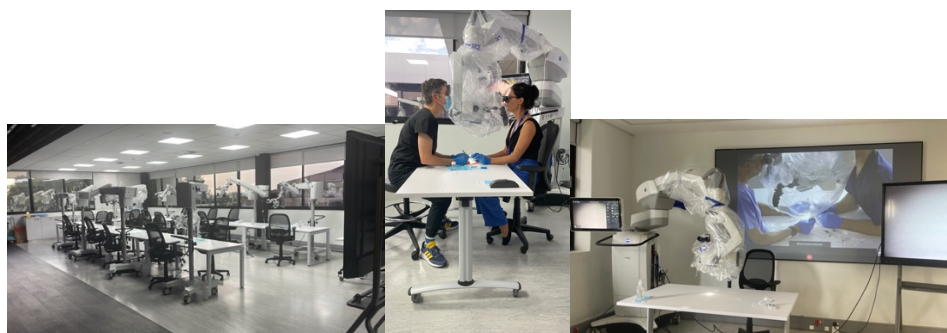
