


## CONGRESS 2011 2-4 SEPTEMBER SUN CITY HOTEL (MAIN HOTEL) SUN CITY COMPLEX

#### **Dear Delegate**

SASSH is proud to announce that the Annual Congress will be held in the Baobab Lecture Halls, Main Hotel, Sun City Complex from 2-4 September 2011.

However, at this stage the President and Executive Committee would like to bring to your attention the following important information with regards Accommodation Bookings at Sun City Complex.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION REDUCTION AND CANCELLATION POLICY FOR ACCOMMODATION BOOKINGS AT SUN CITY

Sun International has strict rules with regards accommodation reservations and the client (in this case SASSH) has to adhere to these arrangements. By contract SASSH is **holding a block booking at the Main Hotel only** and the following policy will be applicable:

Date Range	Total Cancellation Penalty Charge	Reduction Penalty Charge
>180 days before arrival	Equals 50% of rooms held	Full charge for more than 50% of rooms reduced
179-45 days before arrival	Equals 80% of rooms held	Full charge for more than 20% of rooms reduced
44-14 days before arrival	Equals 95% of rooms held	Full charge for more than 5% of rooms reduced
13 to same day arrival	Equals 100% of rooms held	100% of rooms reduced

#### This means:

- 1. **On 6 March** (179 days) SASSH will release 50% of the rooms held without any penalty payment
- 2. On 19 July (44 days) SASSH will release a further 20% of the balance of the rooms held without any penalty payment
- 3. Up to 19 August SASSH will release another 5%
- 4. From 20 August a full cancellation penalty is applicable and payable by SASSH

Thus: if by **the above dates** rooms have not been booked, SASSH will release these rooms in order to avoid paying cancellation fees. The release dates that SASSH have agreed to are as per the table above. We are unable to hold rooms that have not been booked beyond these dates as then SASSH is at risk of incurring cancellation penalties.

Sun International cannot guarantee availability after cancellation of these rooms. There is an overall shortage of rooms in the Greater Sun City complex and there is no accommodation options in the vicinity.

I trust that the above information will thus encourage you to do your reservation at your earliest convenience.
